ROLE OF ADHESION PROMOTERS IN PAINTS & COATINGS

The adhesion is the resistance of the coating to being removed from the substrate. The adhesion promoter for paint is an additive to promote adhesion of the film to the substrate. Without the adhesion promoter, the properties of the applied coating may not be sufficient to meet the final performance requirements.



BYK has additives for solvent borne and waterborne systems which have an affinity for the substrate and the coating and helps strengthen the bonding.


