PIGMENT BLUE 60 - UNIQUE & HIGH-PERFORMANCE PIGMENT FOR BLUE COLOR SPACE

Millions of years ago, scattering of light by oxygen particles gave us abundant blue sky. Much later in 20th century, two pigment chemistries were invented, commonly known as Indanthrone (1901) and Phthalocyanines (1935) that produced blue hues by absorbing most part of the visible



spectrum. The later developed phthalocyanine is more popular today due to much lower cost and overall utility in most coatings' applications. Indanthrone blue is superior in technical performance but due to much higher cost is used in specific applications only.

Indanthrone, also known as Pigment Blue 60 offers unique properties for paint applications over the well-established phthalocyanine blue pigments. It has

high alkali resistance (not effected by efflorescence), excellent weather fastness even in very pastel shades and a clean reddish blue hue. It has high heat stability and excellent for shading white and grey hues while maintaining brightness. This reddish blue is much cleaner than blends of phthalo blue and violet pigments. Applications include high performance architectural, industrial, powder and automotive finishes. Among the organic pigments, it offers the best of all properties to enhance appearance and performance in coatings.

Romesh Kumar is new business development manager at Heubach Colorants. His expertise includes colorants & applications, color measurement and other related subjects. He began his carrier with American Hoechst Corporation and has been affiliated with pigment industry for over 43 years.
