Operations managers are under constant pressure to meet deadlines while continuing to find ways to lower overall production costs while EHS managers are striving to meet and exceed sustainability, health, and ensure safety goals. These issues can be overcome by using improved pump and mixing technologies while significantly lowering energy and maintenance costs. Combining electric driven diaphragm pumps and mixers with PMSM motors that are electronically controlled provides unique opportunities for these improvements when applied to specific raw material transfer, process transfer, filling, mixing, and blending.

Understanding how your local Utility Company can assist with the initial purchase (incentive rebates) combined with reduced daily energy consumption is critical to lowering costs. By employing specific pumping and mixing technologies in key applications, kWh consumption can be reduced by factor of 5x or more.

An understanding of these technologies allows for continued process improvements while lowering total overall operating costs.




